Javier Senosiain is a Mexican architect, graduated from the School of Architecture of the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM). He advocates organic architecture which takes into account the physiographic conditions of a place (orientation, topography, views, environment) and the way in which it is integrated with nature.

The purpose of Senosiain's organic architecture is "to create a space adapted to man according to his environmental, physical, and psychological needs, starting from his origin in nature, as well as from the experiences of man's space throughout history".

The architect Senosiain has concentrated his work on the search for the natural space of man, from which emerged the book BIO-ARQUITECTURA (Bio-Architecture) in search of a space.

Tools of construction and ancestral technologies are chosen with the aim of creating continuous spaces, wide, integral, liberating forms and changing lights that follow the natural rhythm of human movements, spaces where integrated furniture facilitates a current circulation and takes advantage of the greater part of the built area.

Currently the architect Senosiain teaches the classes of "Theory of architecture" and "Design Workshop" at the National Autonomous University of Mexico.

In the field of research and experimentation, he has worked with Ferro-cement for structures and has created structures for use as temporary centering in the production of polyurethane houses sprayed with fiberglass.

From April 11th to June 14, 2019 we will be presenting the exhibition **Javier Senosiain: organic architecture** at the Cultural Institute of Mexico in Miami, which consists of plans, photographs, sketches, models and videos that show various works of the architect. This exhibition was presented at the Palace of Fine Arts in Mexico City in 2017 and at the Cultural Institute of Mexico in Montreal in 2018, venues where lectures were held at the main universities.

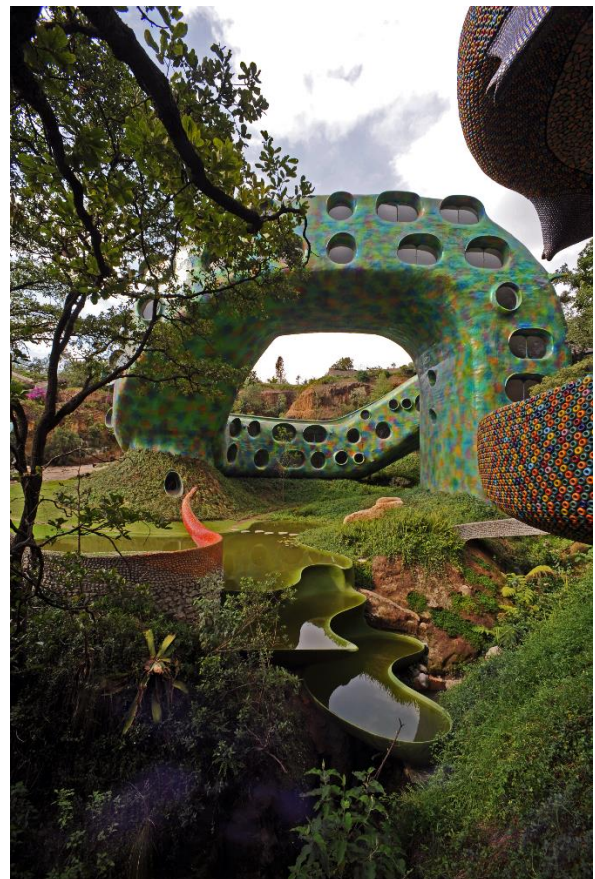
