These awards intend to **encourage excellence in architecture, elevate public consciousness of good design, and recognize those architects** whose work enriches our built environment.

Projects will be reviewed with the **AIA Framework for Design Excellence** in mind; how the project better the community and environment in which it resides.

All entries must be architectural projects designed by licensed architects with offices in Miami-Dade County or Monroe County. Projects may be located anywhere in the world and built projects must have been completed by January 1, 2022.

Projects may be submitted for recognition in the following six categories. The jury may move a project to a different category, upon their discretion.

### BUILT AWARDS

#### ***Architecture Less than 50,000 sf***

Recognizes any type of commercial, industrial, or residential project that exemplifies design excellence, sustainable responsibility, innovation, thoughtfulness, and technique.

#### ***Architecture Greater than 50,000 sf***

Recognizes any type of commercial, industrial, or residential project that exemplifies design excellence, sustainable responsibility, innovation, thoughtfulness, and technique.

#### ***Residential Architecture***

Residential projects include single-family houses and multi-family projects up to 20 units. Large scale apartment or condominium projects must be submitted under architecture.

#### ***Affordable Housing***

Recognizes any project from single- to multi-family that fits within the parameters of true affordability. Both public and private projects are eligible.

#### ***Renovation/Restoration***

Recognizes restoration, renovation, or rehabilitation to existing buildings, including adaptive reuse. A detached addition to an existing building should be submitted under architecture.

#### ***Interior Architecture***

Encourages excellence in interior architecture, elevates public consciousness of good design, and recognize those whose work enhances the interior built environment.

#### ***Divine Detail/Material & Building Technology***

Recognizes architectural ingenuity in the use of a particular material, detail, or building technology; and/or the use of an innovative material or detail in a traditional application bringing about improved results.

The use of building technologies that enable the implementation of design and construction excellence through a seamless integration, as well as the improved management and use of the building.



## UNBUILT PROJECTS

Recognizes outstanding examples of recent, commissioned architectural designs not yet built or complete, as well as to identify non-commissioned projects that exemplify excellence in design while exploring nature and science of the profession. Construction must not be substantially complete prior to submission date.

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## URBAN DESIGN

Recognizes excellent solutions to urban design these projects must have an active client. Submittals may include urban design projects, planning programs, civic improvements, environmental programs, and redevelopment projects. Portions of the project must be under implementation; however, the whole project does not need to be completed. If not completed, project description must include implementation schedule. All entries must be projects designed by licensed architects with offices in Miami-Dade County or Monroe County.

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## PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD (only built projects are eligible)

In order to be included, a maximum of 2 signature images must be identified at time of submittal. If none are identified, the project will not be included.

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## STUDENT DESIGN

This award cites exemplary work by a student in planning, architecture, interior architecture, or urban design while enrolled in a NAAB accredited university architectural program in Miami-Dade County.

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## TEST OF TIME

This award recognizes distinguished single works of architecture and planned developments affecting more than one building, after a minimum period of 25 years has elapsed in which the function, aesthetic statement, and execution can be reassessed. Further, it is the intent of the program to recognize works that, by the influence of their design, have informed or affected the evolution of that design typology.

**Note: Submission must be by architect of record of original work.**

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## FIRM OF THE YEAR (AIA Miami members only)


Entries must represent the firm's last ten years of architectural work, as well as statements of the firm's participation in educational programs, involvement in community service, service to the profession, and AIA Miami. Entries must include material which best describes the firm's achievements, maintenance of an inclusive culture, community involvement, and AIA involvement. Include a minimum of one image with a brief narrative per project (minimum of five projects). **The Firm of the Year must be rounded with involvement in not just one or some, but all of the above.**

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## SMALL FIRM OF THE YEAR (AIA Miami members only)

*(10 employees total in all offices)*

Entries must represent the firm's last ten years of architectural work, as well as statements of the firm's participation in educational programs, involvement in community service, service to the profession, and AIA Miami. Entries must include material which best describes the firm's achievements, maintenance of an inclusive culture, community involvement, and AIA involvement. Include a minimum of one image with a brief narrative per project (minimum of five projects). **The Small Firm of the Year must be rounded with involvement in not just one or some, but all of the above.**



## SUBMITTAL INFORMATION

### STEP ONE

Submit entry form, fee, and classification by **Friday, July 29, 2022**. Entry forms and payments must be made on AIA Miami website: [www.aiamiami.org](http://www.aiamiami.org)

### STEP TWO

Upon receipt of entry form and fees, AIA Miami will send a code number and a Powerpoint template for each entry via email. AIA Miami will then also provide complete submission guidelines and instructions for how and when to upload each submission. No other form of entry will be accepted.

### STEP THREE

A separate Powerpoint for each entry, clearly titled with the project name, code number, and award classification must be uploaded as per the provided instructions. Each entry must be uploaded individually. The deadline to upload all entries is **Friday, August 19 2022**. Upon jury review, finalists will be notified. The number of awards in each category will be at the discretion of the jury.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

All entries must be received in electronic format. Upon receipt of the entry form and fee, the entrant will be provided an official PowerPoint template with step-by-step instructions for use in the electronic submission.

The electronic format facilitates a submission in which all images support the program statement. Each visual should have a purpose as it relates to the larger idea. The photos should contain compelling pieces of information to make the statement visually understood.

Be sure to label drawings clearly and to include a north arrow. **The design of the PPT submission is up to the creator, but the project code number must be included in the upper right section of the slide.** Consider the impact the image will make when projected onto a large screen. Images of the winning projects will be shown at the design awards celebration.
